The IMA Research Foundation (IRF) invites innovative research proposals in the fields of accounting and finance from both academics and industry professionals. Submissions should clearly outline the research project's objectives and scope, and demonstrate its relevance to core management accounting functions, including decision support, planning, and control.

The lead researcher must be a full-time faculty member at an accredited college or university, or a qualified industry practitioner with relevant research experience, credentials, or certifications. Proposals are welcomed as part of the IRF's Academic Grant Program.
