- When not at work, Emma can be found travelling (although not so much recently!), practicing yoga or spending time outdoors.








Commonly heard

Career planning

- 4 main responsibilities
- 4 outstanding tangible achievements
- Company culture
- Define the personality of your future manager who can get the best from you
- "Why statement"




Updating your CV or Resume

- Tailoring to the opportunity, not your current role
- Tangible achievements
- Transparency include years and months, explain gaps
- Bullet points, not paragraphs
- Reverse chronological order, ALWAYS!
- The truth!



Updating LinkedIn





Updating LinkedIn

- Ensure your profile is up to date
- Include some details job titles can be misleading
- Consider your headline
- Connect with the right people
- List relevant skills






Applying to roles: LinkedIn

Networking via LinkedIn


- Connecting with the right people

Preparing for interviews

- Research is key
- Use questions to help you stand out
- Be ready to talk about your key achievements
- Be as specific and diverse as possible in your examples
- STAR technique
 - Situation
 - Task
 - Action
 - Result

Also disguised as...

- Tell me one of your development areas
- What won't I like about you?
- What would your team say you need to improve on?
- What would your boss say you need to improve on?



"What is one of your weaknesses?"

1) Acknowledge the 'weakness'

2) Explain the steps you have taken to address the issue.

3) Describe the steps you would like to take in the future.



Video interviews

- Make sure your technology works!
- Still dress smartly
- Still try to make time for small talk
- Ensure you have an appropriate background
- Consider your camera angle



Most important of all...

Be enthusiastic!
